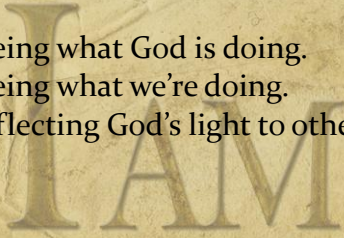
1 John 1
